

Annual Report 2024 – 2025

First and foremost, I would like to thank Lord Almighty for his abundant love and blessing that has kept us marching for 20 years with pride, joy and enthusiasm.

At Shiva Niketan we believe that every individual has a lot of potential and that potential can help accomplish wonders.

I consider it a moment of pride to showcase to you all the happenings and achievements of this academic session 2024– 25.

Shiva Niketan currently has a strength of 904 students including both Primary and Main campuses. We have 62 Academic staffs, 8 subject coordinators, 5 administrative staffs, 6 sports coaches, 8 co-curricular teachers, 4 masters for musical instruments, 21 drivers, 32 school helps.

Excellence in Academics is hallmark of a good institution and without an iota of doubt our students have made us proud. In Grade 10 Board exam 23-24. Top score was 490/500 by Asmitaa S.S. We secured 2 centum in Maths and 1 centum in Tamil. Out of 83 students who appeared for the G10 Board Exam 24 students scored above 90%. All the students who appeared scored above 60%.

In Grade 12 Top score was bagged by Kavin prasanna 485/500 with 1 centum in C S. 17 students out of 74 students who appeared for G12 Board Exams scored above 90%.

Embracing a holistic approach to education, our school takes pride in fostering not just in academic subjects and achievements but also a all-round development of the child through an array of co-curricular activities. Children learn Robotics, Art and Craft, Karate, Skating, Silambam, Dance, Yoga, musical instruments like Guitar, Keyboard, Recorder, Melodica and Western Vocal. ACP, Awakened Citizen Program from Ramakrishna Mission a value education program given to class 6 to 8 students. All the students from grade 1 to 8 have value education classes every week.

School Elections were held in the month of July and members of students Council were elected. We had digital voting wherein students from G6 – 12 voted and elected their student council members. The members of Student Council were inducted through the Investiture Ceremony by our beloved Directors.

In the Kindergarten section and for grade 1 to 3, students have English Language development program which develop their English language skill at a very young age.

In the kindergarten section all the concepts are taught through hands on activities. Students did lot of colouring, painting, dabbing, squeezing, gardening, role play and cooking activities. They had special days like Colour days, Hygiene Day, Toy Party Day, Mom and Me, Dad's cook out, Puppet show. They were also taken to field trips to garden to see different types of plants, fruit shop and field trip to see different types of houses.

In the morning Assembly apart from regular activities like News, Quiz, Thirukural, Doha, Thought of the Day, Interesting Facts, Special Days like Bharathiar Day, Constitution Day, World Environment Day, Tigers Day, Teacher's Day, Children's Day, Youth day were celebrated in the Assembly followed by various cultural and art activities.

International Yoga Day was celebrated on June 21st. All the students and teachers performed Asanas together. Grade 11 students visited Poomalur Government School and performed Yogasanas along with Government school students.

Collective steps were taken to segregate wet and dry waste in our school and students have been practising it on a regular basis. To inculcate self-discipline and responsibility, all the students place wet and dry waste separately and take care of cleanliness in their classroom every day.

All festivals like Krishna Jayanti, Diwali, Ganesh Chaturthi, Onam, Saraswathi pooja, Christmas, Pongal were celebrated with various activities, cultural and art events.

Sports Day for all the classes was celebrated with great enthusiasm, in the month of February.

Aligning to our vision, we at Shiva Niketan believe in experiential learning and encourage our students to be curious and life long learners. Primary section grade 1 to 5, students were taken on Field Trips to Fire Station, Vanalayam, Organic Farm, Olympian Circus and Bamboo Park.

In the middle school and secondary school, students were taken to Padiyur Sarvodaya Sangh to understand production of silk fabric from Silk worm, Book Fair at Codissia , Coimbatore and to a recycling unit to adopt eco- friendly habits.

G9 students visited Tamilnadu Agricultural University, Coimbatore and learnt about Vermi compost, visited department of Genetics, Insect Museum, department of Environment Science and Renewable Energy Source.

Students from G6 to 11 visited the construction site of our new building at different stages to have a knowledge about various stage in construction.

G9 to 12 students were taken on a Domestic Trip to Delhi, Amritsar and Shimla for 5 days.

To encourage and nurture the hidden talents in every child in house Talent Showcase from prep to G12 were held in the month of August. At Shiva Niketan we do not encourage competition till G3. All the students are encouraged to participate. We ensure that every child is given the opportunity to perform.

This year SNS hosted two interschool competitions. Thirukkural Recitation for G4 & 5 students and Interschool Girls Basketball Tournament. Around 17 Schools participated in this Interschool Competition.

Our Shiva Niketan School students participated in various Interschool cultural competition and sports tournaments for the year 2024 – 25 and our students have made us proud by winning laurels.
